The Sonic Landscape of the Cape and Islands

The geographical/topical entity of Cape Cod is one that has been photographed, filmed, lived on, vacationed in, swum, fished, birded, celebrated, revered (rightfully so), and (thanks to Patti Page) sung about. However, this important Northeast ecosystem has only rarely been recorded for its indigenous sounds, its "listenableness."

This year, with the support of the Newbury Comics Faculty Fellowship, Berklee College of Music Professor and former Blue Man Group drummer, Steve Wilkes is embarking on the Hear Cape Cod Project. This project is an attempt to capture aural snapshots of the Cape, over a one-year period, starting in late 2010 and concluding in Fall 2011. Cape Cod faces many potential challenges and developments in the years ahead, from rapidly advancing coastal erosion to the possible implementation of the Cape Wind project. With this in mind, Hear Cape Cod will provide a means to listen to the Cape, as it exists in time, now.
